Dear Applicant

Our arrangements for the distribution of our Admission packs and the procedure for submitting your application for September 2026 places will remain the same.

You can find our Admissions Policy and Admission Form for Emmaus Nursery on our school website, www.emmausschool.co.uk, under Key Information > Admissions.

Please take time to read over each section before completing the Admission form.

Once you have completed the Nursery Admission Form and attached a copy of your child's birth certificate and baptism certificate. You will then receive a reply confirming we have received your application.

Closing date for applications is 15th January 2026

The Admission Committee of the Governing Body will meet in February to allocate Nursery places. **You will be notified at the end of February with either the offer or refusal of a place. It will then be necessary for you to proof of residency documents to prove permanent residence on Croxteth Park Estate.**

Where the Governing Body discovers that a child has been awarded a place as the result of an intentionally misleading application from a parent (for example a false claim on residence in the catchment area), which effectively denies a place to a child with a stronger claim, then the Governing Body is required to withdraw the place. The application will then be considered afresh.

If your application is successful and you gain a place for your child in Emmaus Nursery this does not automatically guarantee your child a place in Reception for the following year.

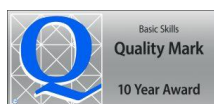
If you wish to apply for a place in Reception for your child for the following year, you will need to apply to the Local Authority in September 2026.
