Dear Applicant

Our arrangements for the distribution of our Admission packs and the procedure for submitting your application for September 2026 places remains the same as last year. You can find our Admissions Policy and Supplementary Faith Form for Emmaus Reception September 2026 intake on our school website, www.emmausschool.co.uk, under Key Information> Admissions.

Please take time to read over each section before completing the Supplementary Faith Form.

Once you have completed the Supplementary Faith Form and attached a copy of your child's birth certificate and baptism certificate. You will then receive a reply confirming we have received your application.

You will also need to apply online at www.liverpool.gov.uk/admissions.

Please follow the step by step instructions and ensure the process has been completed correctly. As part of the Local Authority application process you can name up to 3 schools, doing so does not affect how your application is ranked at any of the 3 named schools.

Closing date for both Liverpool online applications and submitting the supplementary form to Emmaus is
Thursday 15th January 2026

The Admission Committee of the Governing Body will then meet to rank the applications against the criterion in our admissions policy. They will then send their list to the LA who will notify you of your allocation on:

National Offer Day, Tuesday 16th April 2025

This will be via the email address you will have provided on your LA application. Following the acceptance of an offer of a place it will be necessary for you to provide us with proof of residency documents to prove permanent residence on Croxteth Park Estate.

Where the Governing Body discovers that a child has been awarded a place as the result of an intentionally misleading application from a parent (for example a false claim on residence in the catchment area), which effectively denies a place to a child with a stronger claim, then the Governing Body is required to withdraw the place. The application will be considered afresh and a right of appeal offered if a place is refused.
