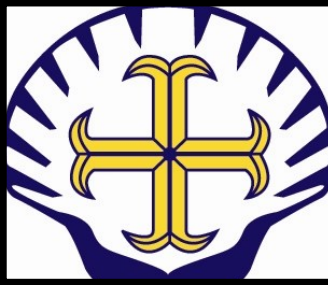

Attendance

It is vitally important that we all play our part in improving school attendance and reaching our target.

Please DO NOT book holidays in term time as these will not be authorised and the Local Authority will issue penalty notices. Refer to the important information regarding the revised framework which came into place last summer. Just ask at the school office if you require a further copy of this.

Our target is 96% and we will be doing our utmost to achieve this. As always, we will be working closely with our Educational Welfare Officer and monitoring the attendance of every child at Emmaus.

Please be reminded that EVERY SESSION COUNTS. Each day has two sessions - a missed morning is preferable to a whole day if your child's condition improves bring them in for the afternoon session.

If your child is going to be absent due to illness you must inform the school office on the first day of absence. You can leave a message on the answerphone giving as much information as possible which includes the reason for absence and the likely return date.

Punctuality is also really important in our school. A late mark is recorded for any child that arrives through the front main entrance. Please ensure you are in school in time to enable your child to line up with their friends and enter their class through their classroom door.
