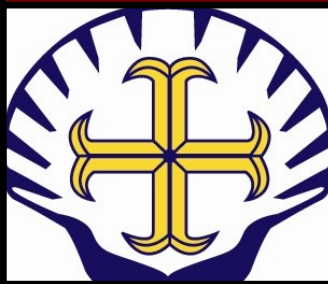

How lovely to see some of our Year 1 and Year 4 girls who took part in the annual awards show last Saturday with their dance group.



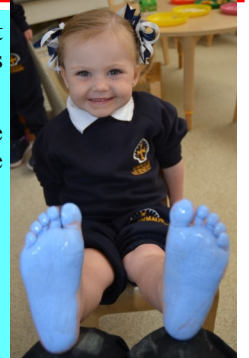
