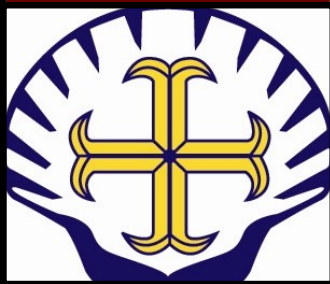

at the Anti Bullying Schools Project in the Signing choir.

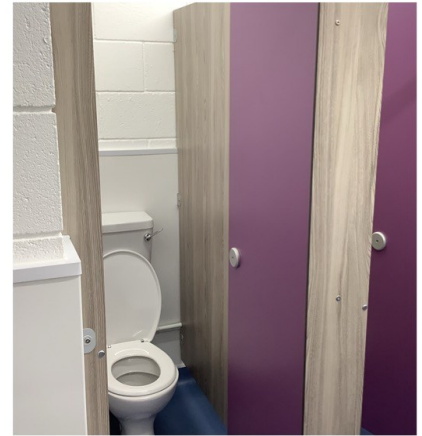
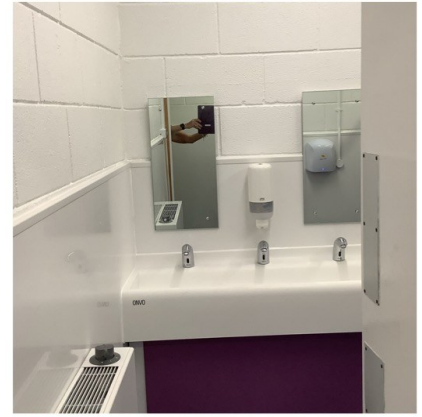
