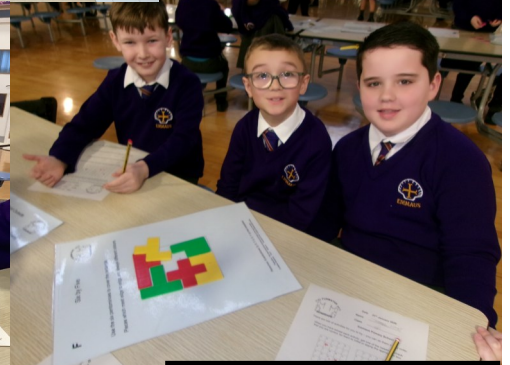
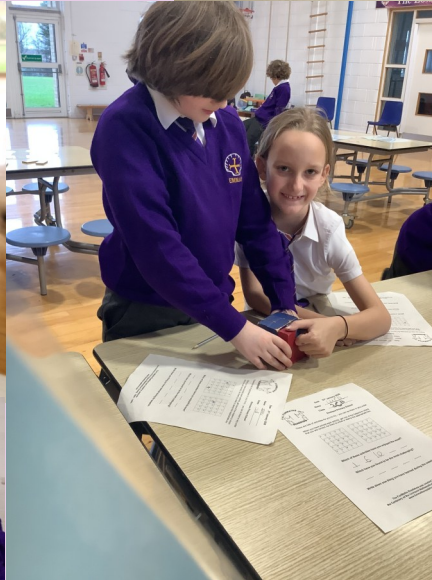
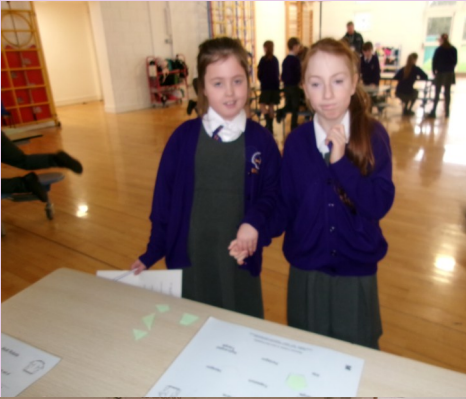
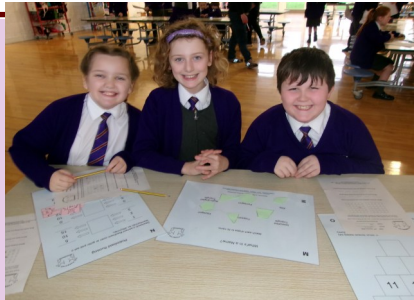


## Maths Workshops in School
