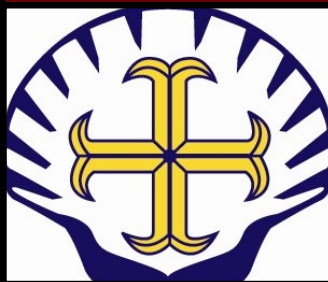

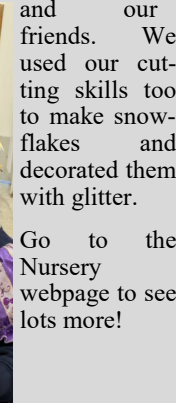


## News from Nursery
