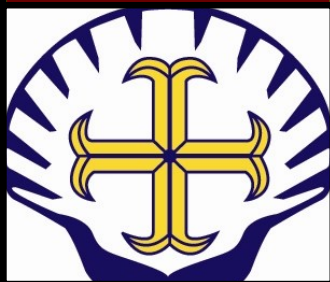

Children are invited to come to school dressed as their favourite character from any book - bring the story along too! Please don't go to any unnecessary expense - just be creative with what you have at home.

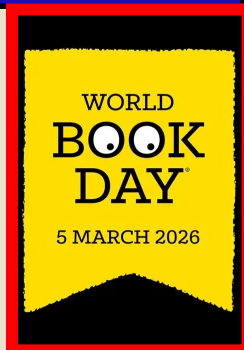
The theme of the day is - 'Drop Everything & Read'

It is important that payments are made by the due date so as school do not receive late payment charges from the holiday companies.

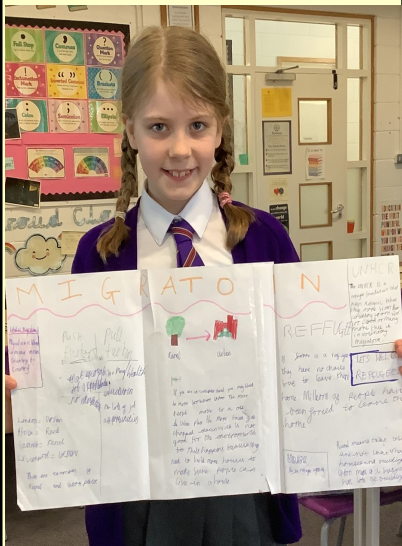

An identical **Allergen Aware Menu** will also be available so that every child can join in the fun.

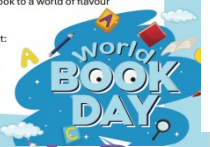
Meals can be ordered in the usual way. If you are new to school meals and would like to give them a try, this is a wonderful opportunity. Please contact the school office for more information.
