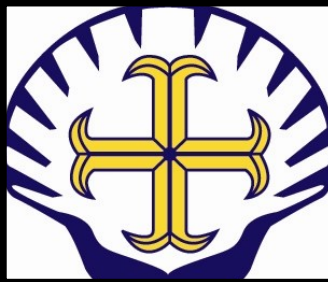

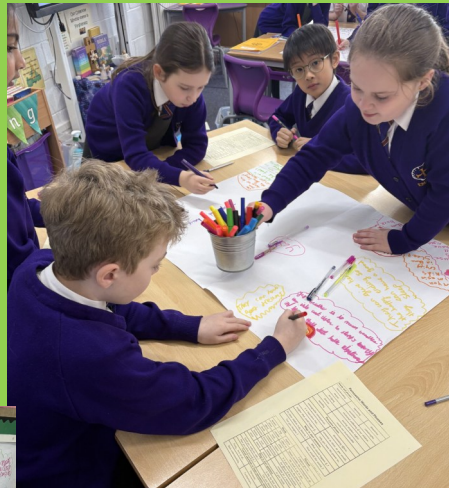
News from Year 4

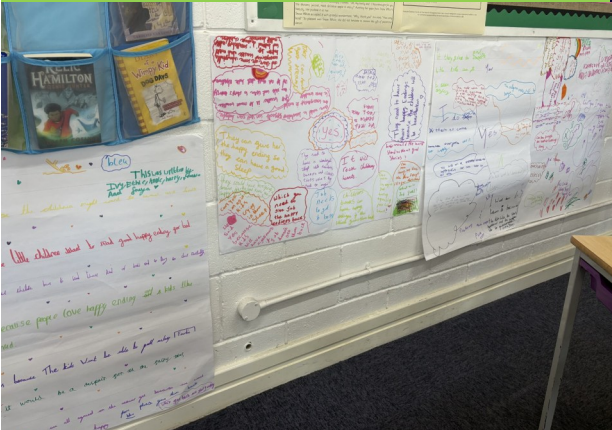


Parents Evening

We Are Moving to Arbor

We are pleased to let you know that our school will soon be moving to Arbor, a modern and user-friendly system designed to make communication and information sharing easier for everyone. All our school data will be collected and now stored on Arbor.

After Easter you will be able to access the Arbor App, initially giving you access to your child's attendance, school messages, school meals and important dates (more features to be added later).

To prevent the need to transfer deficit school meal balances it is important that parents bring their school meal account up to date by Sunday 22nd March. You will be unable to make payments into your school meal account after this date until Arbor is live.
