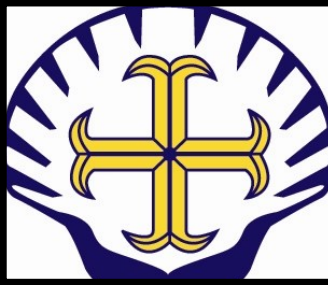

Some of the staff went along to support them and were so delighted to watch so many of our Emmaus family from past, present and future performing with such passion, energy and confidence!

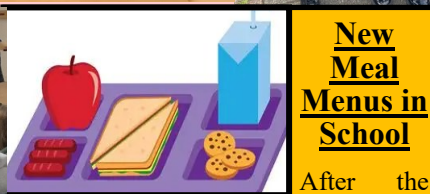


A great big thank you to the Wharmby family for organising such a spectacular event, the children (and staff) have not stopped talking about it this week!

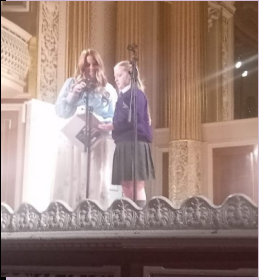
