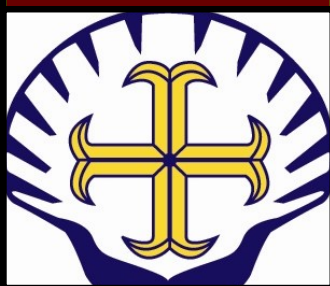

We are using Arbor

Arbor is a cloud based School Management Information System. Emmaus is using Arbor for managing pupil data and attendance.

Using the Arbor Parent App means you can see the live data for your child or children.

We are releasing sections of the app in stages with the view this will be the main school app at Emmaus replacing both SchoolComms and ParentApps by September 2026.

Right now: you can see a breakdown of your child's attendance, report an absence, respond to messages, pay for lunches, update your details / child's details and receive messages/ notifications from school.

From September 2026: All trips, consents, clubs, breakfast and after school club, parents' evenings, school report, notifications letters and newsletters will all be on the Arbor app.

Download the Arbor app now!

How to get started:

1. Go to the App or Google Play Store on your phone and search for 'Arbor' or use the QR Codes here
2. Click 'Install' on Android or 'Get' on iPhone then open the App
3. Tap on "Forgotten password?" then enter your email (this must be the email you have given to school)
4. You will receive an email to reset your password, then accept the Terms & Conditions and you will be asked enter your child's date of birth.
5. When installing make sure that you agree to receive push notifications from the app, otherwise you may not receive messages.

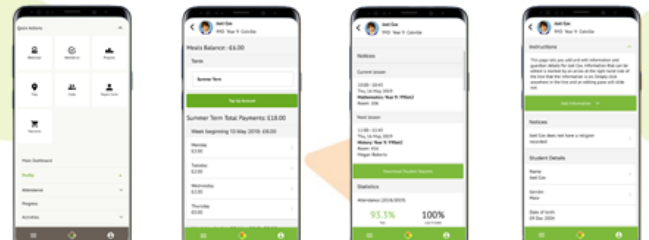


More than one parent can have the Arbor app and receive notifications, a second parent will only be able to access the app if the school office has your email address on the Arbor system.

We currently have 78% of parents who have downloaded the app which is brilliant but we really are aiming for 100% and would urge any remaining parents to download the app at their earliest convenience.

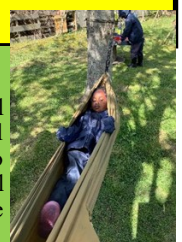
