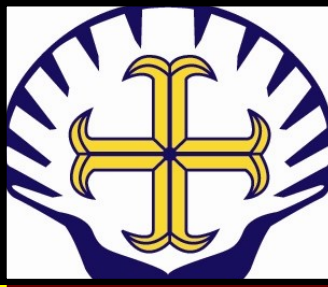

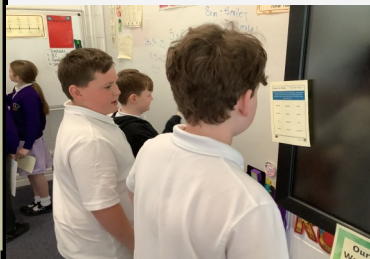
Year 4 Residential to PGL

Dylans Reptiles Visit to Early Years

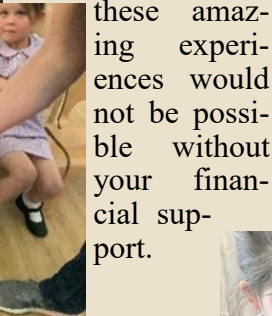


Close encounters with Dylan's Reptiles in Early Years!

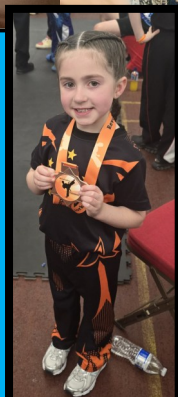
