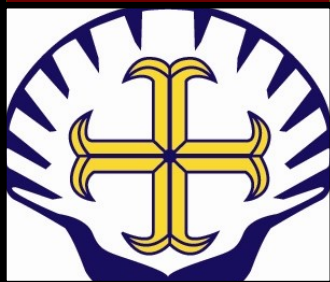

Procedure to follow if your child is absent from school

Day One

- Ensure you contact the school office by 10.00 am on the first day of absence. A message can be left on the school answerphone. **You must provide a reason for absence** and approximate expected return date when possible.
- If your child is attending a medical appointment, please provide documentation from the medical practitioner on the Parentapp : Consent Forms : Medical Appointment Request in order for their absence to be authorised.

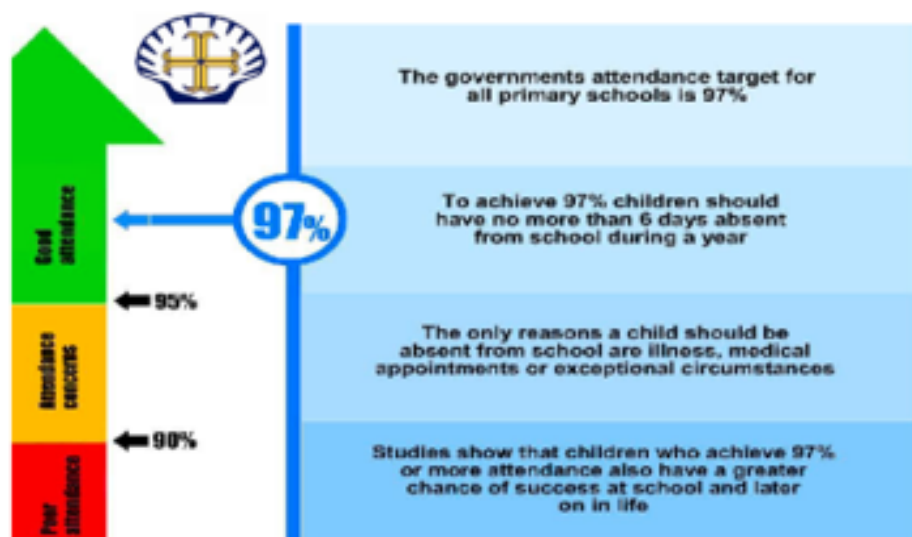
Day Three

- If your child's absence enters into a third day please telephone the school office and **speak personally to a member of staff**. If no-one is available, please leave a message on the answerphone and we will call you back. If we do not receive personal contact from you on day three we will endeavour to contact you and if no contact is made your child's absence will become unauthorised.

Day Five

- If your child's absence lasts for five days or more we would again request you **speak personally to a member of the office staff**, explaining the continued reason for your child's absence, at which point you will be asked to provide medical evidence for the absence to be authorised.
- Weeklong absences where children have informed staff they are going on holiday will result in the absence coded as a G, resulting in a penalty notice. A weeklong absence from school without medical evidence will result in the absence being coded as an unauthorised holiday unless proven otherwise. If you are unable to provide medical evidence you can present yourself, in person, to the school office within the period of absence to update school. The reason for this change is due to the increasing number of families going on term-time holidays without informing school, which is also a safeguarding issue.
- If you have any concerns or queries regarding your child's absence or attendance please speak to Mrs Hope (Attendance Lead) or Mr Williams (Headteacher).

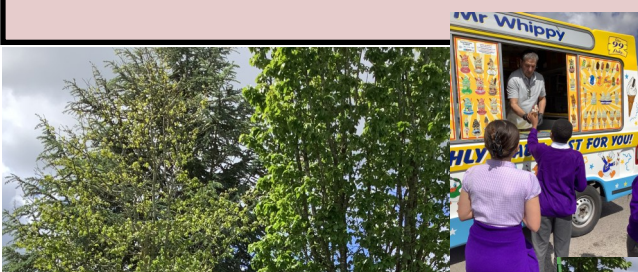
End of Year 6 SATs 2026
