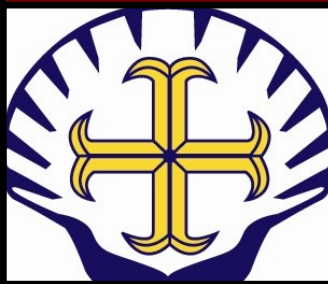

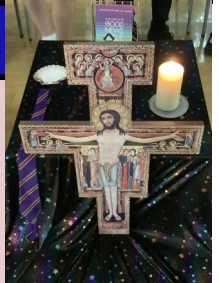


## Dedication Day Service at Emmaus

The children in Year 2 had a lovely day yesterday celebrating Beatles Day!

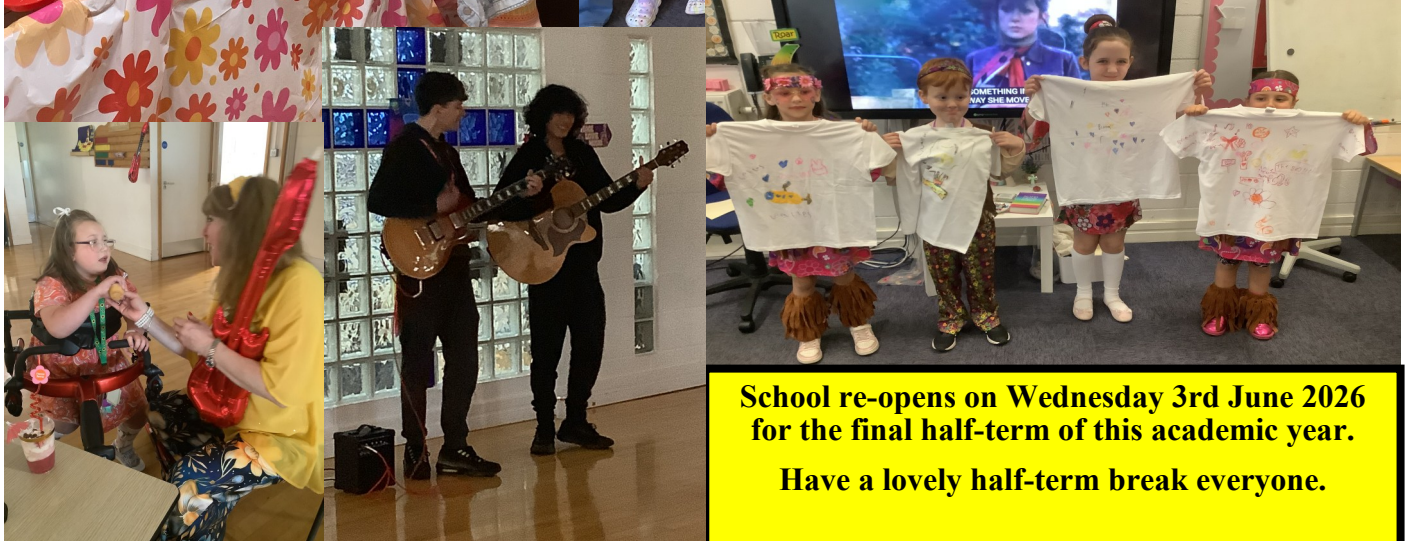
The children decorated t-shirts, made octopus' garden crafts and played Beatles bingo. In the afternoon, we had a wonderful party in the hall with a live band.
