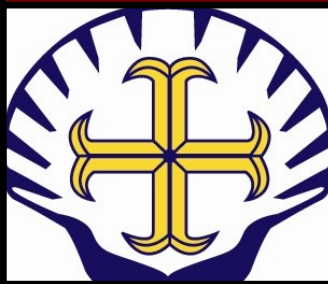

Luca passed his yellow belt grading recently at sho go ryu karate club.

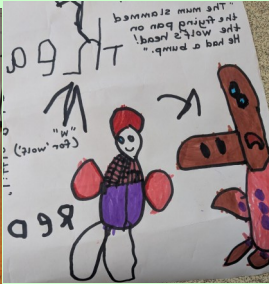

## Great News from Archie

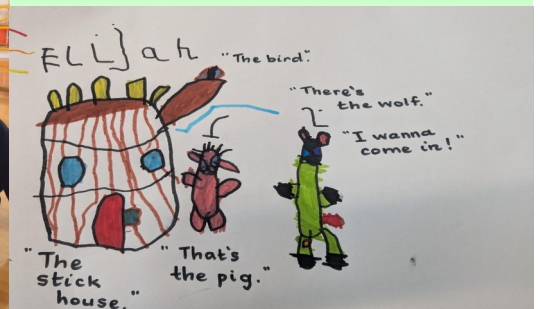
Archie attended a national under 12 football competition for the elite teams throughout the country last weekend.
