Wow - what a week!

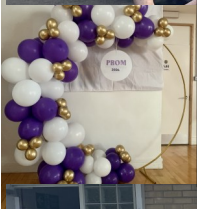
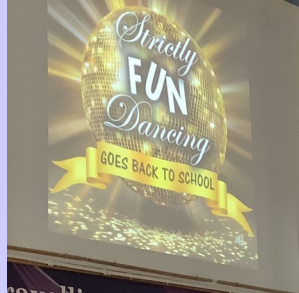
As the saying goes - Don't cry because it's over, smile because it happened.
