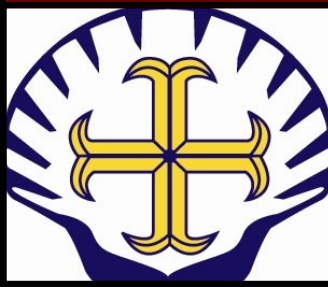

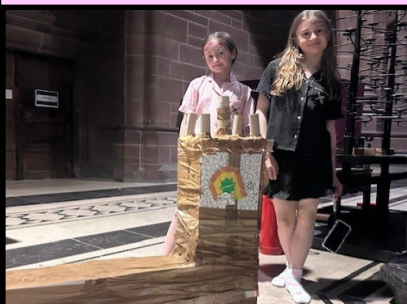
Well Done Isabella and Amber
