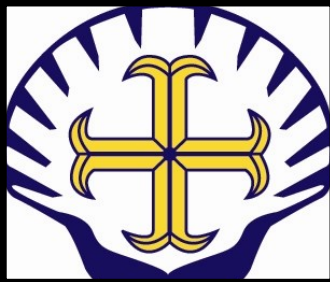

Thank you for your amazing support.

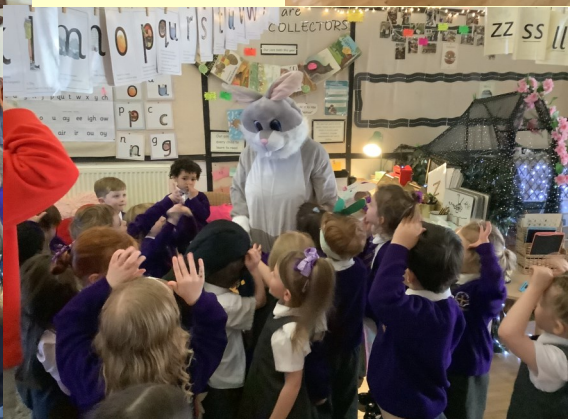


Coverdale Puppets
