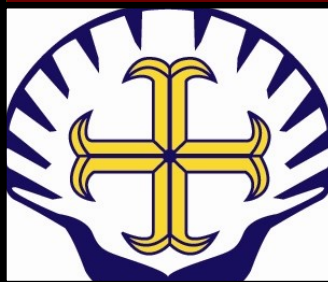

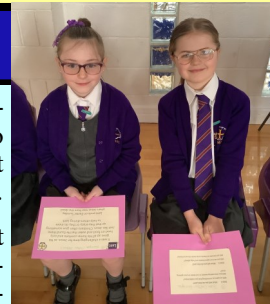


Ash Wednesday Service in School
