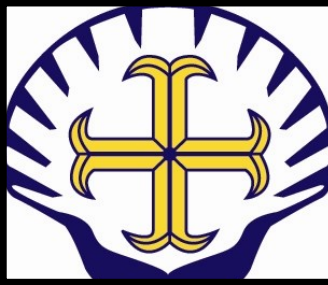

#### Attendance News

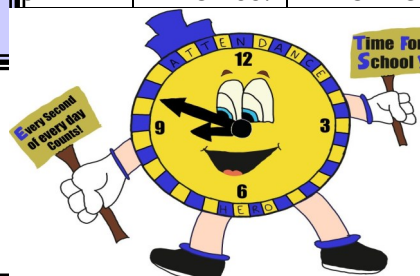
It is wonderful to see one of our youngest classes have the top attendance in the Infants along with one of our most senior classes in the Juniors.
