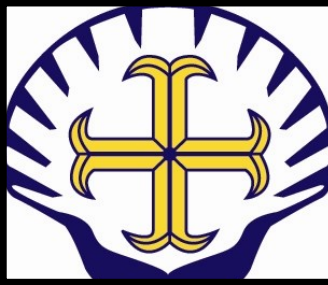

This week we have upgraded our signing-in system in school to a digital system which will run alongside our SIMS school information and registration system.

This will enhance our security and safeguarding and will be used for all staff and visitors to the school.

At a family New Year Party she hosted a raffle and managed to raise £100 for this wonderful cause.

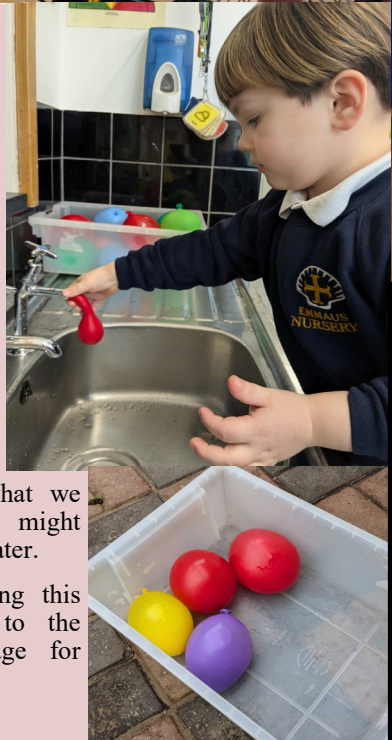
