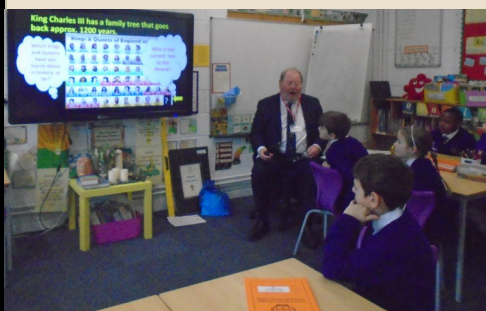


### A Right Royal Visit!

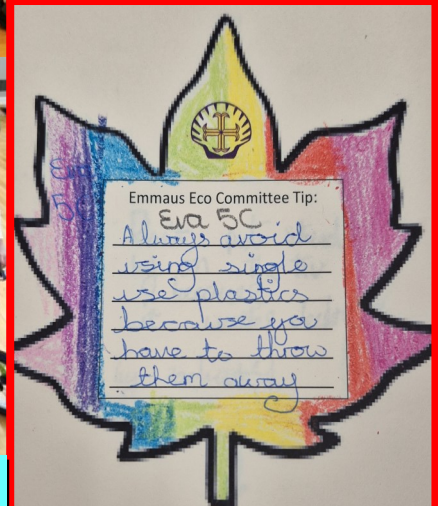
