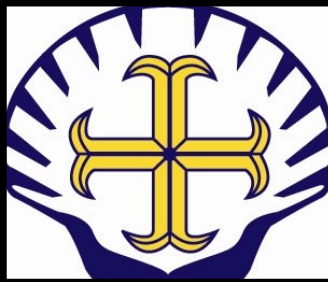

Diwali Dancing

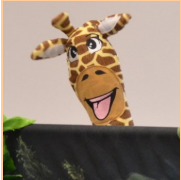
The Nursery children finished off their celebrations of Diwali last Friday by enjoying some traditional dancing with Mrs Neil.
