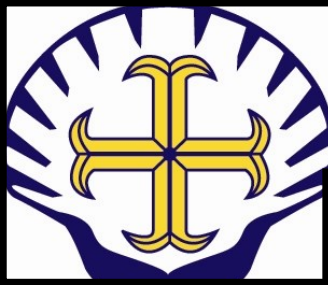

Please remember - every day has two sessions and every session counts.

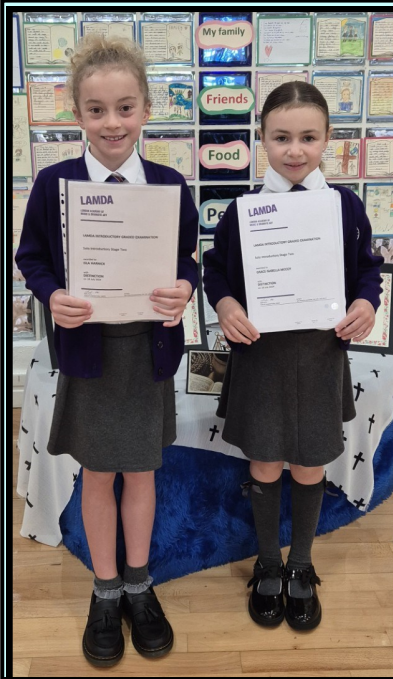

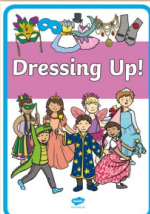


## Eco Council - Tip of the Week

### SAY NO TO PLASTIC CUTLERY AND STRAWS

In England, single-use plastic plates and cutlery are set to be banned. We use an estimated 4.25 billion pieces of disposable cutlery every year. By carrying a spare fork from home, or your own mini-reusable set including reusable straw, you can help cut down on disposables which would have turned into ocean pollution. Where possible, avoid straws completely, even if they're made from paper, as this reduces the need for resources to produce and dispose of them.
