INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Group rate tuition fees are based on around 3 pupils sharing a half hour lesson. There are 10 lessons per term, totalling 30 lessons per academic year. The cost is £7.50 per lesson, £75.00 per term, a total of £225.00 a year. Parents may pay in advance or by 10 monthly instalments of £22.50.

Woodlands Hospice is a registered charity, dedicated to providing hospice care for the people of North Liverpool, South Sefton and Kirkby in Knowsley.

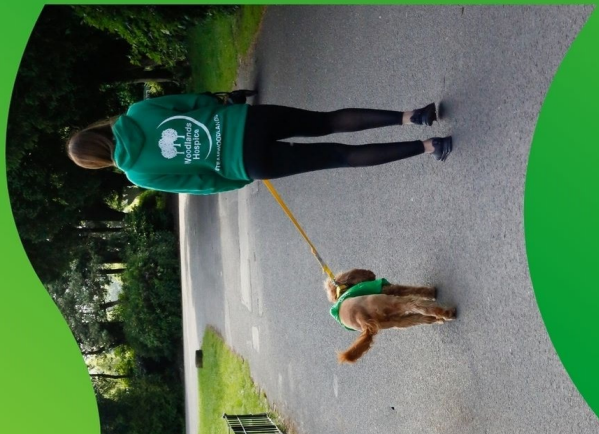
They are a charity close to our hearts and they have supported families in our school in the past. This is taking place in our park on 5th October and will be a lovely family event, please take part if you are able.
