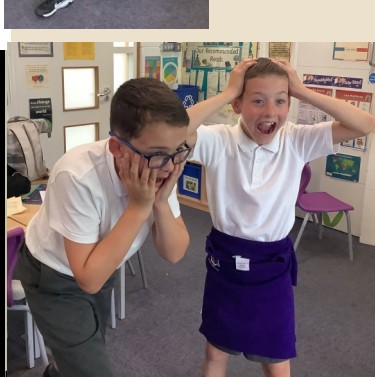
Altru Theatre Visit to Year 5 and Year 6

Brodie got his purple with black stripe and Lottie her orange with black stripe.

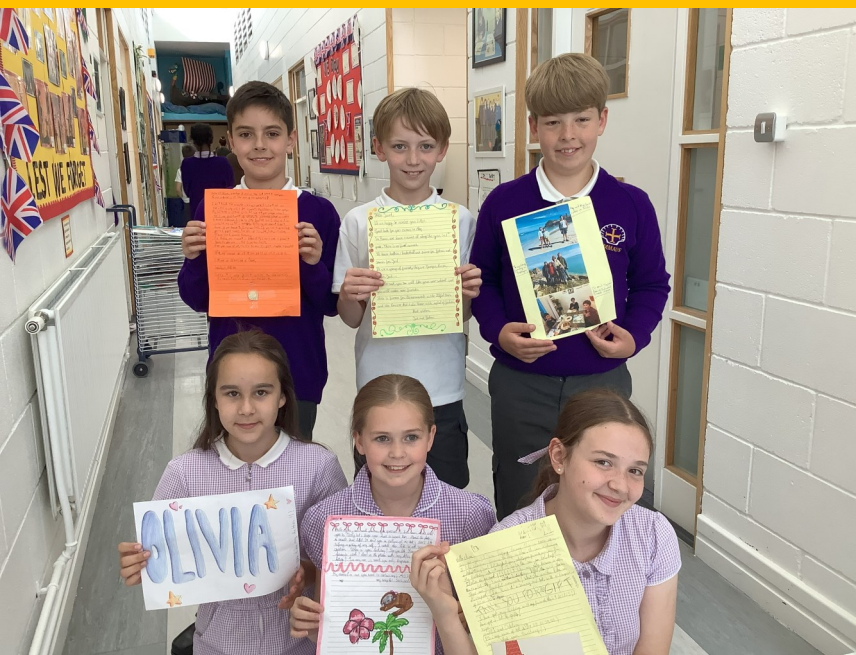
